Qualification ICU ECC 2025

Proposal that there is a transition rule so that the teams who have won their respective categories at the Swiss Nationals be one team qualified for Europeans and the winner of the respective category at the SCO25 will be the second team qualified.

Proposal that Performance Cheer is not qualified for the ICC ECU 2025 through the SCO15 because of point in time in the season.

Consideration of the Board:

The Board supports this proposal since a transition period is understandable and feasible. However, there is no exception for Performance Cheer.

Side Note: According to the ECU rulebook, the Swiss Senior Allgirl Teams have to start in premier. Junior teams will have to compete in Level 5. We will make a proposal to the ECU to stay in the Elite Level for Seniors. For Junior Allgirl we need to talk to the ECU.

Scoresheet Access

Proposal that participating clubs are granted access to the scoresheets of other clubs where the scores are visible. The judges' comments shall stay confident.

Consideration of the Board

Granting access to individual score sheets is problematic and can't be done for the judges discretion and safety.

The judges & rules committee decided that we will provide an average of all the judges points to the teams for each category. This can easily be done with the judging system and will give the teams a deeper understanding of the distribution of the points.

No whole scoresheets will be handed out. You can always decide to discuss the scoresheets with other clubs.

International Judges at the Swiss Nationals

Proposal that future Swiss nationals will only have international judges in the panels and that there is an additional safety judge. This proposal is to ensure independence and fairness as well as safety standards during our national competition.

Consideration of the Board:

In agreement with the safety judge issue. Will be budgeted for in future championships.

However, to further the judges education and sustainability of Swiss judges, having only international judges at the Swiss nationals is counter productive. Independence and fairness has always been ensured.

Communication within the SCA

Proposal to suggest changes concerning communication that will foster transparency, efficiency, and stronger relationships within our association. Implementing response time guidelines, regular and transparent updates, communication committee and dedicated feedback channels.

Consideration of the Board In agreement with the suggestions. However, the association needs people to step up and take over some of these tasks.

Restructuring of the Board

Proposal to either include or exclude all departments in the board.

Consideration of the Board

To have a solely strategic board and operative departments of the association is the goal. However, people need to step up to take on roles in the departments and committees to enable the association to move forward in that direction.
